IOWA'S CANCER GAG ACT

FOLLOWING ITS ACQUISITION OF MONSANTO, THE MULTINATIONAL CHEMICAL COMPANY BAYER BEGAN DEVELOPING A "FIVE-POINT PLAN" TO COUNTER MORE THAN 170,000 LAWSUITS THAT HAVE BEEN FILED RELATED TO ROUNDUP, A WEED-KILLER WIDELY MARKETED FOR AGRICULTURE, RESIDENTIAL, AND COMMERCIAL USAGE. PEOPLE FILING THE LAWSUITS BELIEVE THEIR EXPOSURE TO ROUNDUP CAUSED AILMENTS SUCH AS CANCER — OFTEN NON-HODGKIN'S LYMPHOMA. BAYER HAS LOST MANY OF THESE CASES AND BEEN FINED MORE THAN \$2 BILLION IN DAMAGES.



WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

The bill addresses "failure to warn" claims, where the plaintiff says the pesticide maker should have warned that the pesticide might cause cancer. If passed, this legislation would remove the rights of individuals to sue if they get sick. This bill does not align with lowa values. It prioritizes the profits of foreign corporations over the health and wellbeing of lowans. Iowans and farmers should have the right to to seek relief for pesticide injury.

The health effects of pesticides vary widely by the type of pesticide used. Some pose limited, localized harm, such as eye irritation, skin rashes, and blisters. Other pesticides, such as organophosphates and carbamates, can have more serious effects on the body, including: nervous system decay, impacted brain development, cancer, and endocrine disruption.
